

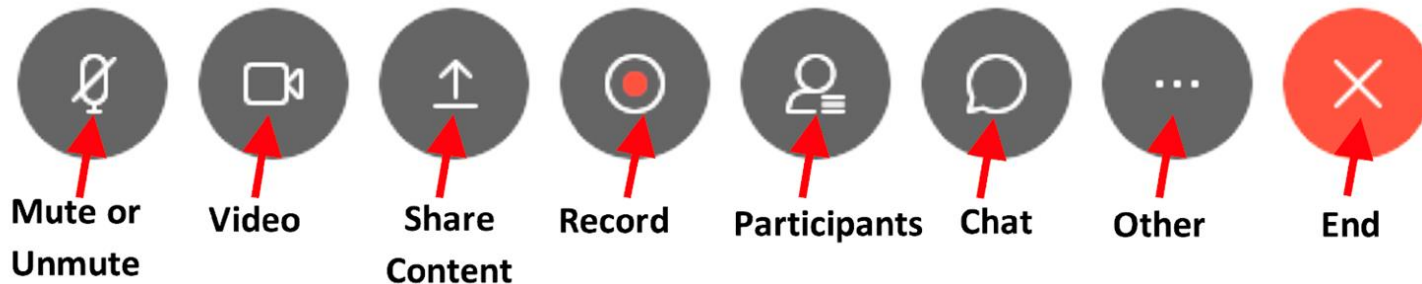

Coordinated Entry System Launch

- Continuing to work on CES launch workplan
- Goal Dates (subject to change)
 - Stage 1 - March 1 - Trainings become available for assessors and access sites
 - Stage 2 - March 15 - Assessments begin
 - Stage 3 - April 1 - Housing matches begin
 - Stage 4 - Ongoing - Continuous Quality Improvement

PIT/HIC Planning Committee

Point-In-Time Count (PIT)

- One-night “snapshot” of homelessness across the country
- Includes an unsheltered count and a sheltered count
- All CoCs must complete unsheltered count in odd years, and are incentivized to do unsheltered count every year
- Sheltered count is completed every year

Housing Inventory Count (HIC)

- One-night “snapshot” of emergency shelter, transitional housing, and permanent housing beds/units dedicated to serving people who are homeless

PIT & HIC must be conducted on same night, in last ten days of January (federal requirement)

Funding Updates

FFY2020 Continuum of Care Program (CoC NOFA)

- HUD has announced that FY2020 will be renewals only
- No new projects
- No reallocation opportunity
- Only sign grant agreements

FFY2021 Continuum of Care Program (CoC NOFA)

- HUD has opened the CoC Registration in esnaps
- No timeframe for NOFA release
- Will be competitive with understanding of current circumstances

Youth Homelessness Demonstration Project (YHDP)

Funding Updates

COVID19 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV)

- ESG-CV2 grant agreements and application/budget templates will be sent out shortly - no changes to funding priorities
- Anticipate additional rounds of ESG-CV from COVID relief bill passed in January and new Biden proposals - these will be added to existing ESG-CV2 agreement through amendment most likely

Funding Updates

COVID19 Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Expect \$400 million to come into Maryland - some will be distributed directly to jurisdictions with over 200k population (8 counties). Biden proposals would double the amount allocated through ERAP.
- Balance of State counties will receive ERAP through State allocation
- DHCD will likely be administrator of State ERAP funds
- Details on how funds will be distributed to counties will be shared ASAP - Continuums of Care and Community Action Agencies will be consulted on program design/implementation
- Portion of funding can be used for admin and case management/housing stabilization services

COVID19 Response

- DHCD working with MDH to clarify how homeless shelters and street outreach teams can best proceed with getting clients and staff vaccinated. We will issue guidance/best practice info to LHCs ASAP.
- LHCs should be working with their local health department(s) to get “in the queue” for vaccines. Maryland vaccine distribution is being handled at the county level.
- Congregate living facilities are in vaccine group 1B (which is open now)
- Vaccine supplies are still very limited - only about 50k doses per week (half of which are dedicated to long-term care/nursing facilities)
