

## **BoS CoC Competition Glossary**

**AC:** Allegany County

**ARD:** The Annual Renewal Demand is the amount of money needed to fund 100% of the renewal projects in the

next year

BoS: Balance of State Continuum of Care, MD-514

**CC:** Cecil County

**CES:** Coordinated Entry System - process developed to ensure that all people experiencing a housing crisis have fair and equal access and are quickly identified, assessed for, referred and connected to housing and assistance based on their strengths and needs

**CoC**: Continuum of Care - a regional or local planning body that coordinates housing and services funding for homeless families and individuals

CoC Bonus: CoC Bonus funding opportunity up to 7% of the CoC's ARD

CoC Program: Name of the HUD Grant

**DV Bonus:** Project that is dedicated to survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault or stalking; bonus funding opportunity up to 10% of the CoC's ARD

**Expansion Projects:** Renewal projects can apply for an expansion to expand existing eligible renewals that will increase the number of units in a project or allow the recipient to serve additional persons

**FC:** Frederick County **GC:** Garrett County **HC:** Harford County

**HMIS:** Homeless Management Information System

**Housing First:** Approach to quickly and successfully connect individuals and families experiencing homelessness to permanent housing without preconditions and barriers to entry, such as sobriety, treatment or service participation requirements

**Joint TH-RRH:** Project that includes two existing program components—transitional housing and permanent housing-rapid rehousing—in a single project to serve individuals and families experiencing homelessness

LHC: Local Homelessness Coalition, term used to describe the former individual CoCs

**NOFO:** Notice of Funding Opportunity

**Performance Review Committee:** Subcommittee of the CoC Board of Directors, makes funding and priority ranking determination submitted for Board approval

**PSH:** Permanent Supportive Housing

RFP: Request for Proposals, all project applicants were required to respond to the CoC RFP

RRH: Rapid Re-housing

**Reallocation:** CoC shifts funds in whole or part from existing eligible renewal projects to create one or more new projects without decreasing the CoC's ARD

Renewal Grants: Projects currently funded and applying for renewed funding this year

**Scorecard:** Renewing project performance is measured via the Renewal Project Scorecard which evaluated project performance, HMIS and general grant management, determines priority order

SM: Southern Maryland (Calvert, Charles & St. Mary's Counties)

**SSO:** Supportive Services Only

**TH:** Transitional Housing

Tier 1: Equal to 93% of the CoC ARD, projects that fall in Tier 1 are conditionally selected for funding by HUD

**Tier 2:** The difference between Tier 1 and the maximum amount of renewal and CoC Bonus funds, projects that fall in Tier 2 are subject to further review and scoring by HUD, who will then conditionally select projects across all CoCs from highest scoring projects to lowest, until funding runs out.

**Transition Grant:** Grant to convert an existing CoC project from one component type to another, transition grants are fully funded by Voluntary Reallocation funds

**WC:** Washington County
