HSP Ad-Hoc Committee

LHC Board members have expressed interest in having more guidance and/or support for determining which projects should be funded at local level through HSP funds:

- Need for local project selection processes to be more transparent/inclusive to service providers
- Integration of more people with lived experience into decision-making
- Support for development of local funding strategy (data and gaps analysis, etc)
- Scoring tools and resources
- More consistency across Balance of State in funding priorities and processes

HSP Ad-Hoc Committee

Proposed Solution

CoC Board establish ad-hoc committee to develop tools, guidance, and processes for LHCs to use for HSP funding application process. The committee would present recommendations and tools to the board for approval/adoption.

Examples of possible work items:

- Develop guidelines for local LHC committees in overseeing the project selection process
- Develop shared communication standards for grantees/subgrantees
- · Develop sample scoring tools LHCs could use to evaluate program design and performance
- Develop written standards for HSP

Long-term, this group could transition to become a permanent "standards committee" in the CoC governance structure for both CoC and HSP funding.

Board Discussion

DHCD has some planning grant funds available for one-time investments in training, consulting services, or other needs to support the CoC. What are the top priorities board members have right now?

Example ideas:

- Conduct a CoC gaps analysis of housing and shelter
- Create a CoC strategic investment plan/action plan
- Develop system and project level performance dashboards
- Training for frontline staff on low-barrier, housing first, trauma-informed care, problem solving conversations, etc
- Grant management training for fiscal staff
- Racial equity organizational assessment and planning (at grantee/subgrantee level)
